DESCRIPTION

The Ben Abney scholarship Fund welcomes applications from college bound high school seniors attending high school in the District of Columbia, Maryland and Virginia (the DMV). Ben Abney has always worked tirelessly in the community helping those in need. He believes in the power of education to transform lives and to shape the future. The Foundation will award, annually, one (1) scholarship for \$1000.00 in his name. The scholarship will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. The applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- 2. The applicant must submit a 350-word essay response to the following prompt: "Why you chose to attend an HBCU and how can it prepare you for your future?"
- 4. The applicant must submit a high school transcript.
- 5. The applicant must submit three letters of recommendations (community member, school official, and a personal friend or relative).
- 6. The applicant must be accepted and attend one of the great Historically Black Colleges and Universities for the next school year.
- 7. Finalist are required to participate in an interview held by the scholarship selection committee.
- 8. The Northern Virginia Kappa Achievement Foundation, Inc. scholarship selection committee will review all applications and select the most qualified candidate. The NVKAF Board of Directors will approve the final selection of the scholarship committee.
